Summary: Staff accountants should possess solid communication, technology, organizational and analytical skills. Companies hiring staff accountants generally look for at least three years' experience, along with a bachelor's degree in accounting or finance by performing the following duties.

Duties and Responsibilities include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- 1. Reconciling sub-ledger to general ledger account balances and other balance sheet account reconciliations.
- 2. Assist in preparing financial statements
- 3. Budget and Forecast variance analyses
- 4. Assisting in the design and preparation of budgets and forecasts for review by management*
- 5. Intercompany accounting and reconciliation
- 6. FX accounting as it relates to translation of balance sheet accounts
- 7. Assist Accounts Receivable department with various AR tasks.
- 8. Preparation of various state tax filings
- 9. Assist accounting team with annual audits.

Work Environment:
